Financial Assistance

All applicants for direct financial assistance through the Maryland Community Development Block Grant Program must disclose any potential conflict of interest related to participation in the program. A conflict of interest may occur if an application is related to or has a business relationship with an employee, officer or elected official of HOC . If it is determined there is a conflict of interest or potential conflict of interest, you may not be approved for assistance. The HOC can request for the State of Maryland CDBG Program to review and make a determination which could result in a waiver allowing for approval.
